

RULES AND RACE REGULATIONS

Svatohorský Downtown Příbram 2026

These regulations are binding for all race participants.

1. Basic Provisions

- **Svatohorský Downtown Příbram 2026 is an individual timed downhill mountain bike race through an urban environment.**
- **The race is not part of any series. The organizer reserves the right to amend these regulations, the schedule or the course of the race if required by safety, operations or event organization.**
- **Riders must follow the instructions of the organizer, the race director and the course marshals.**
- **The organizer reserves the right to interrupt, suspend or terminate the race at any time.**

2. Conditions of Participation

- **The minimum age for participation in the race is 12 years. The relevant age is the age reached on the day of the race.**
- **Riders under 18 years of age may participate only with duly signed consent from a legal guardian.**
- **Riders under 15 years of age may participate only with duly signed consent from a legal guardian and with the legal guardian physically present at the race venue on race day.**
- **Every rider competes at their own risk and must be medically fit to participate.**
- **During training and the race, riders must not be under the influence of alcohol, narcotics or any other addictive substances. The organizer is entitled to carry out random breathalyzer tests; refusal may be grounds for disqualification.**

3. Categories

- **Women – from 12 years of age, valid Czech Cycling Federation license required; the category will be opened with at least 3 female riders.**
- **Open – from 12 years of age, no age or gender distinction, for riders without a valid license on race day; the category will be opened with at least 4 riders.**
- **Masters – 30 years and older, valid Czech Cycling Federation license required; the category will be opened with at least 4 riders.**

- **Junior – 12 to 18 years inclusive, valid Czech Cycling Federation license required; the category will be opened with at least 4 riders.**
- **Elite – 19 to 29 years inclusive, valid Czech Cycling Federation license required; the category will be opened with at least 4 riders.**
- **If a rider does not hold a valid license on race day, they are automatically placed in the Open category.**
- **If a category is not opened due to a low number of entries, the organizer will decide on merging it or reallocating riders.**

4. Registration, Entry Fee and Check-in

- **The maximum number of riders is 140.**
- **Registration is available online only in advance via the naZavody.cz portal. On-site registration will not be possible.**
- **The entry fee is 1000 CZK. Bank account for payment of the entry fee: 2001195208/2010.**
- **Registration becomes valid only after the entry fee has been credited to the organizer's account.**
- **Payment must be made within 7 calendar days of registration; otherwise the spot will be released to another rider.**
- **The latest possible date for the payment to be credited to the organizer's account is Sunday, May 17, 2026.**
- **Cancellation, replacement rider or registration transfer must be handled individually by the rider via e-mail at info@svdtpribram.cz or by phone at +420 608 403 993 (Vítězslav Stránský).**
- **Check-in will take place on Saturday, May 23, 2026 from 09:00 at the start at Svatá Hora in a marked tent.**
- **At check-in, the rider must present an ID document, a valid license if applicable, and sign the relevant liability declaration. Riders under 18 must submit signed consent from a legal guardian.**
- **The start order for the first race run is determined by the order of completion at check-in.**

5. Training and Race Procedure

- **The course is open for training only during the officially announced time. Outside this time, the course is closed.**
- **Training is allowed only with a start number. This race has no uplift to the start.**
- **Before the course opens, riders will be introduced to the course profile and features.**

- The race consists of two timed runs. The final ranking is determined by the better of the two times unless announced otherwise by the organizer. In the case of a Czech Championship race, only the time from the second run counts for the results.
- Only riders with a technically compliant bike, an assigned start number and the mandatory equipment will be allowed to start.
- If a course marshal signals a stop with a red flag and whistle, the rider must stop the run immediately.
- The rider must complete the full course exactly as marked. Cutting the course or failing to follow the organizer's instructions is grounds for disqualification.
- If a rider cannot continue, they must clear the course if possible and immediately inform the nearest course marshal.

6. Mandatory Equipment and Technical Condition of the Bike

- Junior – full-face helmet; back protector or chest protector.
- Elite + Masters – full-face helmet.
- Open + Women – full-face helmet; goggles; back protector or chest protector; knee pads.
- Recommended equipment for all categories: back protector or chest protector, knee, shin and elbow pads, goggles and full-finger gloves.
- The rider is responsible for their mountain bike. The bike must be in good technical condition, equipped with two independent brakes and free from any known damage, especially cracks in the frame and components.
- Tires with metal studs or spikes are not permitted.
- The organizer may refuse to allow a rider to start if their equipment is dangerous or their bike is technically unfit.

7. Safety and Rider Conduct

- Riders must follow the instructions of the organizer and course marshals and behave considerately toward spectators, other riders and the urban environment.
- Riders may stop and gather only in clear, visible sections of the course, not behind corners or near jumps.
- Outside the race course, riders must comply with traffic regulations and other generally binding rules.
- By participating in the race, the rider agrees to the taking of photographs and video recordings for event documentation and promotional purposes.

8. Parking and Important Organizational Information

- Parking for riders is available below Svatá Hora. The parking is paid.

9. Final Provisions

- **Participants are required to familiarize themselves with these regulations and the related documents before the race.**
- **In matters not expressly regulated by these rules, the race organizer shall decide.**
